

(3) submits to the Board:

(i) if contracting in the name of the licensee or another person to provide plumbing services, proof of the liability insurance required under § 12-501 of this title; and

(ii) a renewal application on the form that the Board provides.

(b) No license may be issued or become effective until the applicant pays the fee therefor as follows:

(1) Contractor's license, for each business location, including the fee for one salesman's license	\$[175] 225
Biennial renewal	\$[175] 225
(2) Salesman's license	\$ [50] 75
Biennial renewal	\$ [50] 75
(3) Subcontractor's license	\$ [75] 125
Biennial renewal	\$ [75] 125

(4) Fifteen dollars of these fees are not refundable to cover the cost of processing the applicant's eligibility.

(d) The applicant shall pay a nonrefundable application fee of [\$200] \$300 plus an additional \$20 for each employee of the applicant. The applicant shall pay the \$20 fee for each employee of the applicant at the time the employee is initially employed but is not required to pay the fee on renewal of the license.

420.

(a) Each license issued under this subtitle shall expire biennially on April 30 of each even-numbered year unless renewed by filing an application for renewal with the Secretary and paying a renewal fee of [\$200] \$300.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
