- (b) No license may be issued or become effective until the applicant pays the fee therefor as follows:
- (4) Fifteen dollars of these fees are not refundable to cover the cost of processing the applicant's eligibility.

(d) The applicant shall pay a nonrefundable application fee of [\$200] \$300 plus an additional \$20 for each employee of the applicant. The applicant shall pay the \$20 fee for each employee of the applicant at the time the employee is initially employed but is not required to pay the fee on renewal of the license.

- (a) Each license issued under this subtitle shall expire biennially on April 30 of each even-numbered year unless renewed by filing an application for renewal with the Secretary and paying a renewal fee of [\$200] \$300.
