

(2) The change in name may not impair or divest any property or contract rights acquired or belonging to any person prior to the passage of any [of the] ordinance or resolution.

(3) The redesignated [district] DISTRICT shall have and succeed to all the rights and powers granted the District under this title or under any public general law applicable to Washington County. After the District has been so [designated] REDESIGNATED, the County may not increase or decrease the number of Commissioners from that provided by this subtitle or diminish or change the powers and purposes of the [Authority] AUTHORITY. 6-203. Service areas.

(a) The following "service areas" are established:

Service Area 1 – Subdistrict No. 1 (Halfway), Subdistrict No. 5 (Potomac), and Subdistrict No. 16 (St. James)

Service Area 2 – Subdistrict No. 15 (Maugansville/Orchard Hills) and Subdistrict No. 6 (Fountainhead)

Service Area 3 – Subdistrict No. 9 (Highfield/Cascade)

Service Area 4 – Subdistrict No. 4 (Sharpsburg)

(b) The [county] COUNTY may establish an additional service area. There shall be no more than 5 service areas.

(c) If the [county] COUNTY changes the subdistricts which compose the service areas, the General Assembly shall at its next regular session redefine the service areas. (1985, ch. 448)

Subtitle 3. Commission

6-301.

(a) Commission.

(1) The powers of the District shall be exercised by the Commission, which is composed of the following members:

- (i) One at-large member; and
- (ii) One member from each of the following service areas:
 1. SD-No. 1 (Halfway)
SD-No. 5 (Potomac)
SD-No. 16 (St. James)
SD-No. 5-1 (Cloverton/Green Lawn)
SD-No. 14 (Sharpsburg Pike)
