(4) Insurance obtained in compliance with this section shall relieve the applicant for a [master electrician's] MASTER ELECTRICIAN'S license from any requirement to furnish a separate surety bond.

(5) An applicant for a Restricted Electrician's License shall also comply with the insurance requirements of this section.

(6) Holders of an inactive [master electrician] MASTER ELECTRICIAN'S license are exempt from the insurance requirements of this subsection.

(b) The license fees shall be:

(1) Initial license - \$75;

(2) Annual renewal for active license - \$30;

(3) Inactive license - \$10;

(4) Fee to activate license - \$25; and

(5) Late payment penalty - \$20. (1988, ch. 60)

8-108. Renewal of licenses.

(a) An active license expires on December 31 of each year and is renewable every year upon payment of the fee and delivery of the certificate of insurance, unless the Board has revoked the license.

(b) An individual who holds a valid electrical license may go on inactive status, during which time the licensee may not engage in electrical contracting in Washington County. An inactive license expires on December 31 of each year and is renewable every year upon payment of the inactive license fee. Insurance is not required while the license is inactive.

(c) A licensee may reactivate a license upon a written request to the Board and payment of the reactivating fee and delivery of a certificate of insurance as required by [section 8-107 of this title] § 8-107 OF THIS SUBTITLE. (1986, ch. 586; 1988, ch. 60)

8-109. Revocation of license.

The Board may revoke for proper cause any license or license renewal after a full hearing of all parties in interest. (1957 Code, sec. 215. 1951, ch. 328, sec. 179H; 1970 ed. sec. 12-8; 1984, ch. 289; 1988, ch. 60)

8-110. Display of license.

An individual granted a license or license renewal shall display it in a conspicuous place in the office or place of business of the licensee. (1957 Code, sec. 217. 1951, ch. 328, sec. 179J; 1970 ed. sec. 12-10; 1984, ch. 289; 1986, ch. 586)

8-111. Work under supervision of Master Electrician.
