

(a) Definitions. In this subtitle, the following words have the meanings indicated.

(b) Board. "Board" means the Board of Trustees of the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts.

(c) Museum. "Museum" means the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts. (1970 ed. sec. 41-1; 1983, ch. 133; 1984, ch. 289)

12-102. Board; membership; terms; oath.

(a) Board of Trustees. There is a Board of Trustees of the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts.

(b) Membership. The Board consists of 18 trustees as follows:

(1) 15 trustees appointed by the Board;

(2) As an ex officio member, the [president] PRESIDENT of the Board of County Commissioners or a County Commissioner designated by the [president] PRESIDENT;

(3) As an ex officio member, the [superintendent of schools] SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS of Washington County; and

(4) As an ex officio member, the Mayor of the City of Hagerstown or a [city council] CITY COUNCIL member designated by the Mayor.

(c) Term.

(1) Each trustee serves for a term of 5 years.

(2) The terms of the trustees are staggered as required by the terms of the trustees serving on July 1, 1988.

(3) A trustee serves only for the remainder of a term if the trustee is appointed:

(i) To fill a vacancy in an unexpired term; or

(ii) To succeed a trustee who is holding over.

(4) A trustee serves until the successor of the trustee is appointed and qualifies.

(d) Oath. On taking office, each trustee shall take the oath required by Article I, § 9 of the Maryland Constitution. (1983 ch. 133; 1970 ed. sec. 41-2; 1984, ch. 289)

12-103. Powers of Board.

In order to create and maintain a public museum known as the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts in the City of Hagerstown for the use of the inhabitants of Washington County, the Board may:

(1) Purchase, acquire, lease, or hold in any manner real property that is
