SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

16.

(a) A Class D beer and light wine license shall be issued by the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the place of business is located. The license authorizes its holder to keep for sale and to sell beer and light wines at retail, at the place described in the license, for consumption on the premises or elsewhere. The license may not be issued for any drugstore. The annual fee for the license is \$60, and shall be payable to the clerk, before any license is issued, for distribution as provided in this article.

(x) (1) In Wicomico County the annual fee for [the] A 6-DAY license is \$250, AND THE ANNUAL FEE FOR A 7-DAY LICENSE IS \$350.

(2) THE DAYS AND TIMES FOR SALES OF BEER AND LIGHT WINE UNDER EACH LICENSE ARE AS PROVIDED IN § 105B OF THIS ARTICLE.

In Wicomico County notwithstanding any other provisions of this subtitle, the hours during which the privilege conferred by a beer or beer and light wine Class B (on-sale) hotel and restaurant license and a beer, or beer and light wine (on-sale) license may be exercised, is from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. on the day following, Monday through Saturday,
