SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

40.

(f) In Wicomico County, a [beer, wine and liquor,] Class A (off-sale) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE may not be issued to an individual or partnership unless they have [been bona fide residents of the County for two years next preceding the application for either license] A CLASS B (ON-SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR RESTAURANT 7-DAY LICENSE AND HAVE BEEN IN OPERATION FOR NOT LESS THAN 3 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE APPLICATION FOR THE LICENSE. A [beer, wine and liquor license,] Class A (off-sale) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE may not be issued to any corporation unless the applicants (1) own or are owners of 75 percent of the total issued capital stock of the corporation, and (2) [are bona fide residents of Wicomico County for two years next preceding the application for either] HAVE A CLASS B (ON-SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR RESTAURANT 7-DAY LICENSE, AND (3) HAVE BEEN IN OPERATION FOR NOT LESS THAN 3 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE APPLICATION FOR THE license.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 219

(House Bill 645)

AN ACT concerning

Garrett County - Local Officials - Salaries

FOR the purpose of requiring the Garrett County Commissioners to set the rate of compensation for certain officials, subject to certain limitations; altering the powers and duties of the Garrett County Salary Study Commission; authorizing the Salary Study Commission to make recommendations concerning certain salaries to the County Commissioners; amending certain sections of the Annotated Code of Maryland and the Public Local Laws of Garrett County to provide that certain Garrett County officials' salaries are to be set by the County Commissioners in accordance with this Act; providing that salary changes under this Act may not apply to the salary or compensation of certain incumbent public officers; maintaining the salaries set in certain Acts of the General Assembly; clarifying language; and generally relating to the Garrett County Salary Study Commission and the salaries of certain public officials in Garrett County.
