

Annotated Code of Maryland
(1974 Volume and 1990 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 12 – Garrett County

20-5.

A. [The salary for each] EACH county commissioner [is] SHALL RECEIVE:

- (1) \$20,500 for calendar year 1991;
- (2) \$23,000 for calendar year 1992;
- (3) \$25,500 for calendar year 1993; [and]
- (4) \$28,000 for calendar year 1994; and

(5) For each subsequent calendar year THE SALARY SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 91 OF THE PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF GARRETT COUNTY.

B. (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, each county commissioner is entitled to an expense allowance of at least \$1,200 each year.

(2) Each county commissioner shall submit an itemized account substantiating the amount of expenses.

[(C)]C. Payments under this section shall be paid to the county commissioners in monthly installments.

A. The Garrett County Salary Study Commission is established. It shall study the existing salaries of the Garrett County Commissioners, Treasurer, Sheriff, State's Attorney and Deputy, Judges of the Orphans' Court, Board of Supervisors of Elections, Board of Education, and members of the Liquor Control Board. It shall make recommendations regarding the salaries for these offices and the recommendations shall be sent to the Garrett County Delegation of the General Assembly.

B. The Commission shall meet prior to the 1981 Session of the General Assembly and prior to the beginning of each session every four (4) years thereafter. The members shall elect a Chairperson. The members will serve without compensation.

C. The Salary Study Commission shall be composed of five (5) members as follows:

(1) One (1) member from the Republican Central Committee of Garrett County.
