(A) THE COMMISSION SHALL MEET BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1993 AND BEFORE JANUARY 1 EVERY 4TH YEAR THEREAFTER.

(B) FOUR MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ARE A QUORUM.

91-4.

(A) THE COMMISSION SHALL STUDY THE SALARIES OF THE:

- (1) COUNTY COMMISSIONERS;
- (2) BOARD OF EDUCATION;
- (3) BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS;
- (4) JUDGES OF THE ORPHANS' COURT;
- (5) LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD;
- (6) SHERIFF;
- (7) STATE'S ATTORNEY; AND
- (8) TREASURER.

(B) THE COMMISSION MAY RECOMMEND TO THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AN INCREASE OR DECREASE IN THE SALARY OF ANY OFFICE IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

91-5.

(A) WITHIN 45 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMISSION, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL SET BY ORDINANCE THE SALARY FOR EACH OFFICE INCLUDED IN THE RECOMMENDATIONS:

(1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION; AND

(2) WITH RESPECT TO A PUBLIC OFFICER, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE III, § 35 OF THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION.

(B) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY ACCEPT, REDUCE, OR REJECT BUT MAY NOT INCREASE THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMISSION.

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(a) There is hereby constituted and established in each county a liquor control board, to be appointed and to have the tenure, compensation, powers and duties as provided in this subtitle; provided that in Montgomery County there is hereby constituted and established, effective July 1, 1951, a Department of Liquor Control, which shall be a
