

(j) (1) The County Treasurer of Garrett County [is entitled to a salary of] SHALL RECEIVE:

- (i) \$24,000 for calendar year 1991;
- (ii) \$26,000 for calendar year 1992;
- (iii) \$28,000 for calendar year 1993; [and]
- (iv) \$30,000 for calendar year 1994; and

(V) [for] FOR each subsequent calendar year, THE SALARY SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 91 OF THE PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF GARRETT COUNTY.

(2) Subject to the approval of the County Commissioners, the County Treasurer shall appoint a deputy treasurer. If the County Treasurer determines that additional assistance is required, the County Commissioners shall provide additional staff and shall pay each employee a salary set by the County Commissioners.

(3) The deputy treasurer may not be related to the County Treasurer by blood or [marriage, before] MARRIAGE. BEFORE beginning the duties of deputy treasurer, the deputy treasurer shall execute a bond as required by the Public Local Laws of Garrett County. The deputy treasurer shall have a thorough knowledge of bookkeeping and related subjects, and the duties of the deputy treasurer shall be prescribed by the County Treasurer. The deputy treasurer shall receive an annual salary from the County Commissioners not less than \$4,200, which is to be paid in equal monthly installments.

**Article 33 – Election Code**

2-3.

(a) Each member of the boards of the several political subdivisions of the State shall receive an annual salary of not less than the following amounts:

- (12) Garrett County:
  - [(i) President: \$2,000; and
  - (ii) Members: \$1,700 each.]

THE PRESIDENT AND MEMBERS SHALL RECEIVE THE SALARY SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 91 OF THE PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF GARRETT COUNTY.

**Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

2-309.

(a) The sheriff of a county and his deputies shall receive the annual salaries provided by this section for performing the duties required of them by the Constitution and the laws of this State. They shall be reimbursed for expenses as provided by law.
