

(m) (1) (i) The [salary of the] Sheriff of Garrett County [is] SHALL RECEIVE:

1. \$28,250 for calendar year 1991;
2. \$30,500 for calendar year 1992;
3. \$32,750 for calendar year 1993; [and]
4. \$35,000 for calendar year 1994; and
5. [for] FOR each subsequent year, THE SALARY SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 91 OF THE PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF GARRETT COUNTY.

Article - Education

3-4A-03.

Each member of the County Board is entitled to:

(1) [A] THE salary [of \$3,600 per year] SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 91 OF THE PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF GARRETT COUNTY; and

(2) Reimbursement not exceeding \$400 a year for travel and other expenses, including travel expenses to and from board meetings held in the county at the rate Garrett County pays for mileage.

Article - Estates and Trusts

2-101.

In the estates of decedents law, the word court means the orphans' court in a county, or the court exercising the jurisdiction of the orphans' court in a county.

2-108.

(a) Except in Montgomery and Harford counties, the judges of the courts shall receive compensation and allowances as prescribed by law. Unless otherwise provided, the compensation shall be paid in monthly installments. Mileage or travel expenses may not be allowed to a judge for attending sessions of his court except as specifically provided.

(m) (1) Each of the judges of the court for Garrett County shall receive AN annual [compensation in the amount of \$1,200.] SALARY SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 91 OF THE PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF GARRETT COUNTY.

(2) Each judge shall be reimbursed for traveling to and from the sessions of the court at the rate Garrett County pays for mileage. Each judge shall also receive \$25 for expenses for every day's attendance upon the sessions of the court.
