the extent that the power contained in them is continuing or has not been exercised, unless any law is expressly repealed by this Act, and the validity of any bonds issued under previously enacted laws is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved. This Act, being necessary for the welfare of the inhabitants of the County, shall be liberally construed to effect its purposes. All Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of any inconsistency.

SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 224

(House Bill 762)

AN ACT concerning

Charles County - Housing Fund

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Charles County to establish a Charles County Housing Fund for the purpose of makings loans in connection with the construction of low and moderate income housing projects in Charles County; specifying the maximum amount of funds that may be allocated to the Fund; requiring the County Commissioners of Charles County to adopt certain rules and regulations; and generally relating to the Charles County Housing Fund.

Section 27-17

Article 9 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

(1988 Edition and September, 1990 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 9 - Charles County

27-17.

- (A) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY MAY ESTABLISH A CHARLES COUNTY HOUSING FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING LOANS IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF LOW AND MODERATE INCOME HOUSING PROJECTS IN CHARLES COUNTY.
- (B) THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF FUNDS THAT MAY BE ALLOCATED TO THE CHARLES COUNTY HOUSING FUND MAY NOT EXCEED \$1,000,000.
