## AN ACT concerning

# Injunctions - Action for Custody, Guardianship, Visitation, or Support of Child

FOR the purpose of authorizing an equity court in an action for custody, guardianship, visitation, or support of a child to issue an injunction to protect a party to the action from physical harm or harassment.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article - Family Law

#### 1-201.

- (a) An equity court has jurisdiction over:
  - (1) adoption of a child;
  - (2) alimony;
  - (3) annulment of a marriage;
  - (4) divorce:
  - (5) custody or guardianship of a child;
  - (6) visitation of a child;
  - (7) legitimation of a child;
  - (8) paternity; and
  - (9) support of a child.
