CHAPTER 236

(House Bill 973)

AN ACT concerning

Kent County - Alcoholic Beverages - Boards

FOR the purpose of creating a Board of License Commissioners in Kent County by abolishing the existing system in the County; prohibiting the new system from taking effect until it is authorized by the Kent County Commissioners; specifying the number of members and the election of a chairman; providing for the appointment, qualifications, term, compensation, and removal of a Board member; providing for clerical assistance and the liquor inspector; prohibiting the members, the liquor inspector, and employees of the Board from participating in certain unethical practices while serving on the Board; repealing the Kent County Liquor Control Board, its employees, and its function; and generally relating to creating a substitute Board of License Commissioners and repealing the Liquor Control Board in Kent County.
