

losses that may be sustained by said Board in the operation of such dispensaries. Sixty-six and two-thirds percent (66 2/3%) of all net profits in excess of the above shall belong to and be paid over to the County Commissioners of Kent County on or before July 1 of each and every year, the remaining thirty-three and one-third percent (33 1/3%) of all net profits shall on or before July 1 of each and every year, be paid to the governing body of each of the several incorporated towns of Kent County in which dispensaries are located, pro rata, in the proportion that the profits derived from the sale of alcoholic beverages in said incorporated towns bear to the total amount to be paid over to said incorporated towns.]

[(a) The attorney for the County Commissioners for Kent County shall also be the attorney for the Liquor Control Board for Kent County and shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) per annum in addition to the salary that he receives as attorney for the County Commissioners for Kent County.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act that provide for the alternative Board of License Commissioners in Kent County do not take effect until the Kent County Commissioners pass a resolution authorizing the change.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on the date of the authorization under Section 2 of this Act, the Kent County Commissioners shall appoint 3 initial members to the Board of License Commissioners who shall serve initial terms as follows:

- (1) (i) One member shall serve a term of 4 years;
- (ii) One member shall serve a term of 3 years; and
- (iii) One member shall serve a term of 2 years.
- (2) Thereafter the terms are 4 years.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That any provision of law relating to the Kent County Commissioners serving ex officio as the Board of License Commissioners in conflict with the creation of the Board of License Commissioners under this Act has no force and effect.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of law existing under § 158(j) of Article 2B of the Code shall continue as applicable to the appointed Board of License Commissioners.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
