AN ACT concerning

Howard County – Development Impact Fees

Ho. Co. 10-91

FOR the purpose of authorizing Howard County, by ordinance enacted from time to time by the County Council, to fix, impose, and collect development impact fees for financing, in whole or in part, the capital costs of additional or expanded public schools within the County; and generally relating to the fixing, imposing, and collecting of development impact fees in Howard County.

BY adding to

The Public Local Laws of Howard County

Section 16.1100 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 11. Development Impact Fees"

Article 14 – Public Local Laws of Maryland

(1977 Edition and November, 1990 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 14 – Howard County

SUBTITLE 11. DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES

16.1100.

BY ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL AND SUBJECT TO ANY APPLICABLE EXPRESS PROHIBITION IN THE COUNTY CHARTER, THE COUNTY MAY FIX, IMPOSE, AND COLLECT DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES FOR FINANCING, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, THE CAPITAL COSTS OF ADDITIONAL OR EXPANDED PUBLIC WORKS, IMPROVEMENTS, AND FACILITIES REQUIRED TO ACCOMMODATE NEW CONSTRUCTION OR DEVELOPMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
