CHAPTER 241

(House Bill 996)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County – Bailiffs

FOR the purpose of altering the compensation of bailiffs in Washington County to be the salary set by the Circuit Court for Washington County and approved by the County Commissioners of Washington County; repealing an obsolete provision of law that relates to bailiffs in Washington County; and generally relating to bailiffs in Washington County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

2-507.

(a) A bailiff shall receive the compensation provided in this section. Unless otherwise provided, the amount is a per diem sum for each day he attends the circuit court.

(22) Washington County—[\$17.50] AS SET BY THE COURT AND APPROVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
