9-102.

At any time after the termination of a marriage BY DIVORCE, ANNULMENT, OR DEATH, an ~~AN~~ equity court may:

(1) consider a petition for reasonable visitation by a grandparent of a natural or adopted child ~~of the parties whose marriage has been terminated~~; and

(2) if the court finds it to be in the best interests of the child, grant visitation rights to the grandparent.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be construed to deny or limit the visitation rights of other individuals.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 248**(House Bill 1135)**

AN ACT concerning

Charles County - Public Local Laws

FOR the purpose of deleting certain obsolete or unnecessary provisions from Article 9 - Charles County of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, involving the functions, operations, requirements, or duties of the Charles County Government, the County Commissioners, certain other officials, and the courts within Charles County; deleting certain provisions concerning maintenance of certain fences, the recording of certain instruments, conflicts of interests by members of certain law firms, handling of certain funds, and concerning public roads and bridges, real property transfers, sewerage disposal systems, and the sale of certain county property; deleting certain provisions concerning the Charles County Sanitary District, Inc.; deleting certain provisions concerning tax sales; altering certain publication requirements; altering a certain funding requirement; deleting certain publication requirements; altering certain requirements concerning contracting for publishing; changing the title of the Director of Finance to be "Deputy County Administrator for Fiscal Services"; deleting references to the Public Works Department and substituting, as appropriate, references to the Department of Planning and Growth Management and the Department of Facilities; eliminating a certain requirement concerning control of certain water and sewerage systems; making certain corrections and stylistic changes; and generally relating to certain functions, operations, prohibitions, requirements, or duties affected by certain provisions in the Public Local Laws of Charles County.
