

Sale of Public Property"; 111-1 through 111-18, inclusive, and the chapter heading "Chapter 111 Sanitary District"; 122-1 through 122-4, inclusive, and the article heading "Article I Sewage Disposal Systems"; 125-1 through 125-3, inclusive, 136-3 and 136-10 through 136-13, inclusive, of Article 9 - Charles County of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland be repealed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 9 - Charles County

15-1.

The County Commissioners [of Charles County are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to] SHALL adopt a building code for the county [as soon as is practicable after June 1, 1965].

24-1.

The County Commissioners [of Charles County are authorized and directed to] SHALL prepare and publish [biennially] ANNUALLY, in such form as they shall determine [following each regular session of the General Assembly in odd years], a cumulative supplement to the Code of Public Local Laws of Charles County. The supplement shall include [such] WHATEVER ordinances, [resolutions] RESOLUTIONS, or [rules of] REGULATIONS THAT HAVE BEEN ADOPTED BY the County Commissioners [as the Commissioners deem desirable] WHICH THEY DIRECT to be included in the supplement.

27-3.

THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL CONTRACT FOR PUBLISHING ALL MATTERS REQUIRED BY LAW TO BE PUBLISHED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. THE CONTRACT SHALL BE FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST ONE YEAR.

27-6.

B. [(1)] Copies of county documents; fees. [He shall, upon] UPON application, THE CLERK SHALL exhibit the books, papers and levies in [his] THE CLERK'S office and make certified copies or extracts [thereof] OF THEM for any person [demanding the same and] WHO REQUESTS THEM. THE CLERK SHALL charge for the [same] COPIES, for the use of the county, such fees as are chargeable by the Clerk of the Circuit Court for similar work[, and such]. THE copies, under the Seal of the County Commissioners, [shall be] ARE evidence to the same extent as the originals would be if produced in proceedings in court or otherwise. All fees received from this source[, however,] shall be accounted for to the County Commissioners by [said] THE Clerk and Treasurer.

[(2)] Transfer Clerk. The Clerk to the County Assessor shall act as transfer clerk and shall enter on the assessment books all transfers of property in Charles County and shall keep such hours as shall be set by the County Commissioners.]
