SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 253

(House Bill 1323)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation – Offer Cycles

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation to suspend a certain offer cycle for fiscal years 1992 and 1993 only.

BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

Article – Agriculture

Section 2-508(b) and 2-510(b)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1985 Replacement Volume and 1990 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Agriculture

2-508.

(b) Beginning with fiscal year 1979, and in each fiscal year thereafter, the foundation shall determine the maximum amount which may be expended for allotted purchases of easements on land located within each county. The maximum amount which may be expended for allotted purchases of easements in any county in any fiscal year shall be:

(1) An amount, to be used for general allotted purchases, equal to one twenty-third of one half of the total amount to be allotted, which amount shall be divided equally between the 2 offer cycles; and
