- (C) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A STOP WORK ORDER AGAINST ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY REGULATION, ORDER, APPROVED PLAN, OR MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT.
- (D) (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY REGULATION, ORDER, PLAN, OR MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IS LIABLE FOR A PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 WHICH MAY BE RECOVERED IN A CIVIL ACTION BROUGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT. EACH DAY A VIOLATION CONTINUES IS A SEPARATE VIOLATION UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
- (2) THE COURT MAY ISSUE AN INJUNCTION REQUIRING THE PERSON TO CEASE THE VIOLATION AND TAKE CORRECTIVE ACTION TO RESTORE OR REFOREST AN AREA.

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- ON OR BEFORE JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT OR LOCAL AUTHORITY SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SENATE ECONOMIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS COMMITTEE A REPORT ON:
- (1) THE NUMBER, LOCATION, AND TYPE OF PROJECTS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE;
- (2) THE AMOUNT AND LOCATION OF ACRES CLEARED, CONSERVED, AND PLANTED IN CONNECTION WITH A DEVELOPMENT PROJECT;
- (3) THE AMOUNT OF REFORESTATION AND AFFORESTATION FEES
 AND NONCOMPLIANCE PENALTIES COLLECTED AND EXPENDED; AND
- (4) THE COSTS OF IMPLEMENTING THE FOREST CONSERVATION PROGRAM.
- SECTION 2.—AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if Chapter _____ (S.B. ____/H.B. ____) (The Maryland Growth and Chesapeake Bay Protection Act) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1991 becomes effective, Section 5 1607 of Section 1 of this Act shall be null and void.
- SECTION 3.—AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if Chapter ____ (S.B. _____) (The Maryland Growth and Chesapeake Bay Protection Act) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1991 becomes effective.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
