SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (A) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL APPLY TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES FOR A FEDERAL AND STATE CRIMINAL RECORDS BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION FOR EVERY EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT, WITHIN THE FIRST MONTH OF EMPLOYMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT.
- (2) THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY SHALL PROVIDE THE REQUESTED INFORMATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 27, §§ 742 THROUGH 755 OF THE CODE.
