CHAPTER 274

(Senate Bill 59)

AN ACT concerning

Department of Juvenile Services – Criminal Background Investigations

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Juvenile Services to apply to the Criminal Justice Information System for a criminal background investigation of certain employees; requiring the Department to submit certain information as part of the application; and generally relating to criminal background investigations for certain employees of the Department of Juvenile Services.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 83C – Juvenile Services

2-132.

(A) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL APPLY TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES FOR A FEDERAL AND STATE CRIMINAL RECORDS BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION FOR EVERY EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT, WITHIN THE FIRST MONTH OF EMPLOYMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT.

(2) THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY SHALL PROVIDE THE REQUESTED INFORMATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 27, §§ 742 THROUGH 755 OF THE CODE.
