- (2) A POLICE OFFICER WHO IS ON A VESSEL OF A COUNTY, MUNICIPAL, STATE, OR FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY MAY DISPLAY AND OPERATE FLASHING BLUE LIGHTS OR SIGNAL DEVICES WHILE RESPONDING TO OR OPERATING AT THE SCENE OF AN EMERGENCY OR PURSUING A VIOLATOR OR SUSPECTED VIOLATOR OF THE LAW.
- (D) THE OPERATORS OF ALL VESSELS SHALL YIELD RIGHT OF WAY AND STOP WHEN APPROACHED BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY VESSEL OPERATING ITS FLASHING BLUE LIGHTS OR SIGNAL DEVICES.
- (D) ON THE IMMEDIATE APPROACH OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT VESSEL LAWFULLY USING A FLASHING BLUE LIGHT OR SIGNAL DEVICE, AN OPERATOR OF ANOTHER VESSEL, UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY A POLICE OFFICER, SHALL:
 - (1) YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY; AND
- (2) <u>STOP THE VESSEL AND STAY IN THAT POSITION UNTIL THE LAW ENFORCEMENT VESSEL HAS PASSED.</u>
- (E) AN OPERATOR OF A VESSEL MAY NOT ELUDE OR ATTEMPT TO ELUDE A POLICE OFFICER WHO VISUALLY OR AUDIBLY SIGNALS GIVES A VISUAL OR AUDIBLE SIGNAL TO THE OPERATOR TO STOP.
- (F) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND UPON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING:
- (1) FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE, \$500 OR IMPRISONMENT OF 2 MONTHS OR BOTH: AND
- (2) FOR THE SECOND OFFENSE, \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT OF 1 YEAR OR BOTH
- (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION(C) OR (D) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500.
- (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION:
- (I) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH; AND
- (II) FOR A SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 2 YEARS OR BOTH.
