(IV) THE GOOD FAITH OF THE COMPANY CHARGED IN ATTEMPTING TO ACHIEVE COMPLIANCE AFTER NOTIFICATION OF THE CURRENT VIOLATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

**CHAPTER 277**

**(Senate Bill 68)**

AN ACT concerning

**Vehicle Laws - Renting or Leasing**

FOR the purpose of ~~clarifying that~~ altering a certain definition to limit the application of certain provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law ~~which apply to rental vehicles also apply~~ to certain leased vehicles; defining a certain term; requiring that certain records be maintained; providing that police officers and certain representatives of the Motor Vehicle Administration may inspect certain records; and generally relating to the rental or leasing of motor vehicles.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Transportation**

12-107.

(A) IN THIS SECTION "LEASE" MEANS THE RENTAL OR LEASING OF A VEHICLE FOR A PERIOD EXCEEDING 180 DAYS.

(B) The Administration may conduct investigations and inquiries and require additional information concerning:

- (1) Any application made to it under the Maryland Vehicle Law; or
- (2) Any other matter subject to the jurisdiction of the Administration.
