- (C) EACH PERSON WHO LEASES A MOTOR VEHICLE, TRAILER, OR SEMITRAILER TO ANOTHER PERSON SHALL KEEP A RECORD OF:
- (1) THE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF THE LEASED VEHICLE; AND AND, IF ONLY A SEMITRAILER OR TRAILER IS LEASED, THE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE TO BE USED TO TOW THE TRAILER OR SEMITRAILER;
  - (2) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE LESSEE;
- (3) THE NUMBER OF THE LICENSE TO DRIVE OF THE INDIVIDUAL WHO WILL DRIVE OR TOW, AS THE CASE MAY BE, THE LEASED VEHICLE; AND
- (4) THE DATE AND PLACE OF ISSUANCE OF THE LICENSE TO DRIVE.
- (D) ANY POLICE OFFICER OR AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ADMINISTRATION MAY INSPECT THE RECORDS KEPT UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.

In this title, "rent" means to rent or lease FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING 180 DAYS.

## **CHAPTER 278**

(Senate Bill 74)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Port Administration <u>MeComas Street Terminal</u> and Maryland Port <u>Commission – Membership and Property Reversion</u>

FOR the purpose of <u>altering the eligibility for appointment to the Maryland Port Commission;</u> <u>limiting the compensation of certain commissioners to reimbursement of expenses;</u> repealing the requirement that any transfer of the McComas Street Terminal to the Maryland Port Administration shall provide that, if the Maryland Port Administration is abolished, the Terminal shall revert to Baltimore City; and generally relating to the McComas Street Terminal Maryland Port Commission and Maryland Port Administration.
