

(2) The licensee shall be subject to all rights, regulations and conditions from time to time prescribed by the Commission.

(b) (1) For any violation of the provisions of this article [or of], any regulation of the Commission, OR ANY CONDITION FROM TIME TO TIME PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSION the Commission may:

(i) Suspend or revoke a license; or

(ii) Impose on the licensee a fine of not more than \$5,000 per day of racing scheduled for the licensee.

(2) In determining the penalty to be imposed under paragraph (1) of this subsection, the Commission shall consider:

(i) The seriousness of the violation;

(ii) The harm caused by the violation; and

(iii) The good faith or lack of good faith of the licensee.

(c) If any license is suspended or revoked or if a licensee is fined, the Commission shall state publicly its reason for so doing, and cause an entry of such reasons to be made on the minute book of the Commission, and its action shall be final, subject to judicial review as provided under Title 10, Subtitle 2 of the State Government Article.

(d) Any fine imposed on a licensee shall be paid from the licensee's share of the takeout.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
