CHAPTER 287
(Senate Bill 177)

AN ACT concerning

Pensions – Expense Fund – Termination Date

FOR the purpose of altering a certain termination date for an authorization for certain allocations to certain expense funds of the several retirement and pension systems of the State of Maryland.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
Chapter 767 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1989
Section 2

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 767 of the Acts of 1989

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989. It shall remain effective for a period of [three] FIVE years and, at the end of June 30, [1992] 1994, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

(Senate Bill 178)

AN ACT concerning

Retirement and Pensions – Deductions from Allowances

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of Trustees for the Maryland State Retirement and Pension Systems to allow by rule or regulation certain additional payroll deductions; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to deductions from allowances of members retired from the Maryland State Retirement and Pension Systems.
