- <u>2.</u> <u>BEFORE JULY 1, 1991 WITH AN ON-SALE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PRIVILEGE ONLY MAY NOT BE CHANGED OR ALTERED TO INCLUDE AN OFF-SALE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PRIVILEGE;</u>
- 3. BEFORE JULY 1, 1991 WITH BOTH ON- AND OFF-SALE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PRIVILEGES MAY CONTINUE TO BE SOLD, RENEWED, OR TRANSFERRED WITHIN THE DISTRICT WITH BOTH PRIVILEGES; AND
- 4. BEFORE JULY, 1991 MAY NOT INCLUDE AN OFF-SALE PRIVILEGE FOR SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FROM 12 MIDNIGHT ON SATURDAY TO 2 A.M. ON MONDAY.
- (IV) In addition to the other requirements provided for in this subsection, in the 47th Legislative District of Baltimore City the restaurant shall have a minimum:
- 1. Capital investment of \$250,000 for restaurant facilities not including the cost of the land or building; and
 - 2. Seating capacity of 75 persons.

- (c) (1) The prohibitions in this section do not apply to special 1-day licenses or to Class B beer, wine and liquor restaurant licenses to bona fide restaurants having:
- [(1)] (I) A minimum capital investment of \$150,000 for restaurant facilities or \$250,000 for restaurant facilities in the 47th legislative district of Baltimore City, not including the cost of land and building; and
 - [(2)] (II) A minimum seating capacity of 75 persons.
- (2) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY AND EXCEPT FOR LICENSES ISSUED BEFORE JULY 1, 1991, A NEW CLASS B BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE ISSUED FOR USE IN A RESTAURANT WITHIN THE 47TH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT OF BALTIMORE CITY—MAY—NOT—AUTHORIZE—THE—LICENSEE—TO—SELL—ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR OFF PREMISES CONSUMPTION.
- (2) LICENSE PRIVILEGES FOR CLASS B BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSES ISSUED IN THE 47TH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN BALTIMORE CITY ARE AS PROVIDED IN § 19(C-1) OF THIS ARTICLE.

- (b) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class B beer, wine and liquor license may be exercised are from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m. on the day following.
- (2) <u>In Annapolis the hours shall be as fixed by the Mayor, Counselor and</u> Aldermen of the City of Annapolis.
