(4) IN THE 47TH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE HOURS FOR OFF-SALES UNDER A CLASS B BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE FOR USE IN A RESTAURANT ARE AS PROVIDED FOR IN § 19(C-1) OF THIS ARTICLE.

(a) (4) (i) [In] EXCEPT FOR THE CLASS B SUNDAY OFF-SALE LICENSE PROHIBITION IN THE 47TH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN BALTIMORE CITY AS PROVIDED FOR IN § 19(C-1) OF THIS ARTICLE, IN Baltimore City and Baltimore County, a Class B and a Class C beer and light wine or beer, wine and liquor licensee may sell alcoholic beverages at a bar or counter on Sunday.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to the 47th District of Baltimore City as it was configured on January 1, 1991.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

**CHAPTER 291**

**(Senate Bill 241)**

AN ACT concerning

**Baltimore City – 47th Legislative District – Alcoholic Beverages**

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the transfer of an alcoholic beverages license into the 47th Legislative District of Baltimore City as configured on a certain date.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
