(Senate Bill 242)

AN ACT concerning

Dorchester County - Sale or Lease of Riparian Rights to Property

FOR the purpose of providing that the County Commissioners of Dorchester County may not sell or lease the riparian rights of certain County property in the City of Cambridge unless certain provisions are made for the public sale or lease of the property by competitive bidding a competitive process in a certain manner; and authorizing the County Commissioners of Dorchester County to take certain actions for certain purposes.
