

- (1) Fraudulently or deceptively obtains or attempts to obtain a certificate for the applicant or certificate holder or for another;
- (2) Fraudulently or deceptively uses a certificate;
- (3) Violates this subtitle; {or}
- (4) Violates any regulation adopted by the Department under this subtitle;

~~(5) DOES NOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE AND OF THE REGULATIONS GOVERNING YOUTH CAMPS.~~

~~(B) (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE AND NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 FOR ANY SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE.~~

~~(2) EACH DAY THAT A YOUTH CAMP OPERATES ILLEGALLY AFTER A FIRST CONVICTION IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.~~

14-409.

Except as otherwise provided in § 10-405 of the State Government Article, before the Department takes any action under § 14-408 of this subtitle, the Department shall give the person against whom the action is contemplated an opportunity for a hearing before the Department.

14-410.

The Department or an official acting under authority granted under this subtitle may not restrict, determine, or influence the curriculum or ministry of a youth camp in the State.

14-411.

This subtitle may be cited as the "Maryland Youth Camp Act".

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
