beverages; authorizing the court to order that the individual's driving privilege be suspended for a certain period of time and that the individual participate in community work programs for a certain number of hours under certain circumstances; providing certain exceptions; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to the penalty for certain individuals who fraudulently misrepresent their age in order to buy or receive alcoholic beverages through the use of false age identification.

FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to suspend the license of adults of certain ages for certain Code violations concerning alcoholic beverages that involved the use of a driver's license or a document purporting to be a driver's license; altering the periods of suspension applicable to minors who commit certain Code violations concerning alcoholic beverages under certain circumstances; requiring the Administration to suspend for certain periods the license of a minor for certain Code violations that involved the use of a driver's license or a document purporting to be a driver's license; authorizing the Administration to modify certain suspensions or issue restricted licenses under certain circumstances; providing for certain notices and procedures; defining a certain term; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to the suspension of licenses of minors and certain adults for certain Code violations under certain circumstances.
