- (f) (1) [If]—EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF a person is found by the District Court to have committed a Code violation, that person shall be required to pay a fine in an amount not to exceed \$500.
- (2) If the violation is a repeat offense, that person shall be required to pay a fine in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.
- (3) (I) IF A PERSON WHO IS AT LEAST 18 BUT UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE IS FOUND BY THE DISTRICT COURT TO HAVE COMMITTED A CODE VIOLATION UNDER § 400, § 402, OR § 403 OF THIS SUBHEADING, THE COURT SHALL REQUIRE THAT PERSON TO PAY A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.
- (II) 1. IF A PERSON IS SUBJECT TO THE FINE UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE COURT MAY ORDER THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION TO SUSPEND THE PERSON'S DRIVING PRIVILEGE FOR 6 MONTHS FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE OR UNTIL THE PERSON IS 21 YEARS OLD FOR THE SECOND OFFENSE.
- 2. (II) IF THE A PERSON SUBJECT TO SUSPENSION UNDER THIS SUBPARAGRAPH DOES NOT HOLD A LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE ON THE DATE OF THE DISPOSITION, THE SUSPENSION SHALL COMMENCE ON THE DATE THE PERSON APPLIES AND BECOMES OUALIFIED TO RECEIVE A LICENSE.
- 3. <u>(III)</u> THE COURT MAY MODIFY A SUSPENSION IMPOSED UNDER THIS SUBPARAGRAPH TO PERMIT A PERSON TO DRIVE BETWEEN THE PERSON'S RESIDENCE AND PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT OR A REQUIRED ALCOHOL EDUCATION OR TREATMENT PROGRAM.

- (3) (I) IN THIS PARAGRAPH "DRIVER'S LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE OR PERMIT TO DRIVE A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS ISSUED UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS STATE OR ANY OTHER JURISDICTION.
