AN ACT concerning

Juvenile Law - Restitution

FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum amount of restitution that a juvenile court may order certain persons to pay for certain acts; authorizing the court to enter a judgment an order of restitution against the parent of a child, the child, or both even if the child is charged as an adult; defining certain terms; requiring an opportunity for a hearing before judgment an order of restitution may be entered against a parent under certain circumstances; and generally relating to restitution by a child and the child's parent.
