

Preamble

WHEREAS, The State Board of Architects has been subject to an evaluation to determine the appropriateness of waiver pursuant to § 8-403(e) of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act; and

WHEREAS, The Legislative Policy Committee has reviewed the organizational and fiscal status of this Board and has determined that the Board is operating in a reasonable manner and that further review is not necessary at this time; and

WHEREAS, The Legislative Policy committee recommends that the State Board of Architects be waived from review under the Maryland Program Evaluation Act until the next cycle of reviews, which must be completed by July 1, 2002; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Government

8-403.

(c) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (e) of this section, on or before July 1, 1992, an evaluation shall be made of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes and regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units:

[(1)] State Board of Architects (§ 3-201 of the Business Occupations and Professions Article);

(2)] (1) Board of Boiler Rules (Article 48, § 169 of the Code);

[(3)] (2) State Board of Dental Examiners (§ 4-201 of the Health Occupations Article);

[(4)] (3) Board of Examining Engineers (§ 4-1 of the Public Local Laws of Baltimore City);

[(5)] (4) State Health Services Cost Review Commission (§ 19-202 of the Health – General Article);

[(6)] (5) Insurance Commissioner and Division (Article 48A, §§ 14 and 15 of the Code);

[(7)] (6) State Board of Examiners of Landscape Architects (§ 9-201 of the Business Occupations and Professions Article);

[(8)] (7) State Board of Master Electricians (§ 6-201 of the Business Occupations and Professions Article);

[(9)] (8) State Board of Physician Quality Assurance (§ 14-201 of the Health Occupations Article);

[(10)] (9) State Board of Nursing (§ 8-201 of the Health Occupations Article);
