amount on each type of recordable instrument to be recorded among the land records and financing statement records; requiring that expenditures from the Fund be made pursuant to an appropriation in the State budget; requiring that the Fund be subject to a certain audit; requiring that disbursements from the Fund supplement certain budgeted funds; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the establishment of a Circuit Court Real Property Records Improvement Fund.

- (A) (1) THERE IS A CIRCUIT COURT REAL PROPERTY RECORDS IMPROVEMENT FUND.
