SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Education**

6–107.

(d) A volunteer aide is considered an agent of the county board for the limited purposes of:

- (1) Comprehensive liability insurance coverage under §4–105 of this article;
- and
- (2) Workmen’s compensation coverage under Article 101, §21 of the Code.

**Article 101 – Workmen’s Compensation**

21.

(b) The following shall constitute employees subject to the provisions of this article, except as exempted under subsection (c) of this section:

(10) [Student teachers] VOLUNTEER AIDES, STUDENT TEACHERS, and student interns as provided in [§ 6–108] §§ 6–107 AND 6–108, RESPECTIVELY, of the Education Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if Chapter \_\_\_\_ (H.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1991 takes effect, this Act shall be void and of no effect October 1, 1991.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
