- (a) Except as provided herein, appropriations to the programs listed in this section shall be subject to the following restrictions:
- (1) Funds may be expended only for the capital programs and projects identified in Section 1 except as expressly authorized by statute and may not be transferred to any other programs or projects. In programs for which multiple projects are listed, including 30.01.02.02 and 39.01.01.03, the restriction is applicable to the amount listed for each project included as part of the total appropriation.
- (2) Expenditures for capital programs and projects may not exceed the amounts indicated in Section 1 for those programs and projects with the exception of transfers from the Contingency Fund as provided in the law. In programs for which multiple projects are listed, including 30.01.02.02 and 39.01.01.03, the restriction is applicable to the amount listed for each project included as part of the total appropriation.
- (3) Expenditures from these appropriations are capital expenditures governed by Section 7–305 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- (b) Funds appropriated to the revolving loan accounts of the Division of Housing Finance of the Department of Housing and Community Development may be transferred among those accounts to the extent and in such manner as is expressly authorized by law for those programs, provided that aggregate expenditures may not exceed the amount stated in Section 1 for those programs.
- (c) In program 37.01.21.07, expenditures for the State Action Loan for Targeted Areas Program may not exceed \$1,100,000. Funds appropriated for that program may not be transferred to any other program by budget amendment or otherwise.
- SECTION 29. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, in order to effect budgetary actions not involving numerical reduction to appropriations, the number of permanent positions authorized for the following agencies shall be reduced by the number indicated:
