- (6) The Babe Ruth Museum shall grant and convey a perpetual preservation easement on the exterior and interior of the improvements, where appropriate, and on the land to the Maryland Historical Trust, in form and substance acceptable to the Trust.
- (A) THE BABE RUTH MUSEUM SHALL GRANT AND CONVEY TO THE MARYLAND HISTORICAL TRUST A PERPETUAL PRESERVATION EASEMENT TO THE EXTENT OF ITS INTEREST:
- (I) ON THE LAND OR SUCH PORTION OF THE LAND ACCEPTABLE TO THE TRUST; AND
- (II) ON THE EXTERIOR AND INTERIOR, WHERE APPROPRIATE, OF THE HISTORIC STRUCTURES.
- (B) THE EASEMENT MUST BE IN FORM AND SUBSTANCE ACCEPTABLE TO THE TRUST AND THE EXTENT OF THE INTEREST TO BE ENCUMBERED MUST BE ACCEPTABLE TO THE TRUST.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1991.
