(a) (4) (I) THE FUND MAY CANCEL A POLICY COVERING A VEHICLE IF:

1. THE VEHICLE'S TEMPORARY REGISTRATION ISSUED UNDER § 13-405 OR § 23-107(B) OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE HAS EXPIRED; AND

2. THE VEHICLE IS NOT OTHERWISE VALIDLY REGISTERED IN THIS STATE.

(II) THE CANCELLATION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE NO EARLIER THAN THE DATE FOLLOWING THE DATE OF EXPIRATION OF THE VEHICLE'S TEMPORARY REGISTRATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

**CHAPTER 340**

**(House Bill 80)**

AN ACT concerning

**Retirement and Pension Systems - Retired Members - Reemployment as Elected Official *or Constitutional Officer for a County***

FOR the purpose of ~~excluding~~ *exempting* certain members of the Employees' Retirement System, the Teachers' Retirement System, the Pension System for Employees of the State of Maryland, or the Pension System for Teachers of the State of Maryland from certain restrictions on retirement benefits upon reemployment under certain circumstances; providing for the construction of this Act; and generally relating to retirement benefits for reemployed members of the Maryland State Retirement and Pension Systems.

Preamble

WHEREAS, Article 73B, §§ 11(15)(b), 86(9)(b), 117(14)(b), and 145(13)(b) of the Annotated Code of Maryland provide for reemployment of a member of the Employees' Retirement System, the Teachers' Retirement System, the Pension System for Employees of the State of Maryland, and the Pension System for Teachers of the State of Maryland, respectively; and

WHEREAS, Each of those provisions requires that if a retired member is reemployed in a permanent position with a participating municipal corporation, that member's retirement allowance payments shall be suspended until the member's later retirement; now, therefore,
