CHAPTER 347

(House Bill 130)

AN ACT concerning

Fishing - Oyster Taxes, Surcharges, and License Fees

FOR the purpose of altering certain taxes and license fees for harvesting oysters and other shellfish; prohibiting certain persons from catching oysters for sale without possessing a valid license and paying a certain surcharge; requiring certain revenues to be used for oyster repletion activities; requiring the Department to assess a certain surcharge on certain licenses for the purposes of certain seafood marketing programs; providing for the collection, disposition, and use of the marketing surcharges; requiring the Department to review certain marketing programs under certain conditions; and generally relating to taxes, surcharges, and license fees for the management and enhancement of the harvesting and marketing of fish.
