

Article 41 – Governor – Executive and Administrative Departments

4-501.

In the construction of this subtitle, the following definition shall conclusively determine the meaning of the terms used:

(13) “Mandatory supervision” is a conditional release from imprisonment which is granted to any person sentenced after July 1, 1970 to the jurisdiction of the Division of Correction who has served the term or terms, less the deductions provided for in Article 27, §§ 700 AND 704A of the Code. This conditional release was previously referred to as “mandatory release”.

4-612.

(a) A person under mandatory supervision AS DEFINED IN § 4-501(13) OF THIS TITLE shall be issued a written order, specifying the terms and conditions which must be met, in order for the person under mandatory supervision to serve the remainder of the term outside the confines of a correctional institution.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 355

(House Bill 186)

AN ACT concerning

Dental Hygienists – Continuing Education

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Dental Examiners, after consulting with certain persons, to ~~establish~~ adopt regulations establishing continuing education requirements for licensed dental hygienists; requiring licensed dental hygienists to submit satisfactory evidence of compliance with certain continuing education requirements when renewing their license to practice dental hygiene; specifying that the Board may not require compliance with certain regulations prior to a certain date; authorizing the Board to accept completion of certain courses as counting towards satisfaction of certain requirements; and generally relating to continuing education requirements for dental hygienists.
