Secretary, in lieu of individual separation notices, a notice setting forth the reason for such layoff, together with a list of the names and social security numbers of the workers affected. In cases of unemployment because of a labor dispute, the employer shall file with the Secretary, in lieu of individual separation notices, a notice setting forth the existence of such dispute, without any statement as to the nature of such dispute and shall submit with such notice a list of the names and social security numbers of the workers affected.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Labor and Employment

8-627.

- (a) (2) An employing unit who submits a separation notice under this subsection shall:
- (i) complete the notice on a form or in a manner that the Secretary requires; and
- (ii) submit the notice no later than the [4th business day] 8TH CALENDAR DAY after the day of the request.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991 and shall remain in effect until the taking effect of Section 2 of this Act.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect October 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 357

(House Bill 232)

AN ACT concerning

Cecil County - Alcoholic Beverages License for Restaurants

FOR the purpose of establishing a Class BLX beer, wine and liquor on-sale license for certain qualifying restaurants in Cecil County; establishing an annual fee for the license; providing for the scope of the license; providing for certain license requirements; exempting the license from certain prohibitions; and providing for the hours and days of sale under the license.
