- (2) The total user fees assessed by the Commission shall be equal to [twice the net State contribution. The total user fees assessed by the Commission may not exceed \$2,500,000 in any fiscal year] THE GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION OF THE COMMISSION MAY NOT EXCEED \$3,000,000 IN ANY FISCAL YEAR.
- (3) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, FOR FISCAL YEAR 1992 THE TOTAL USER FEES ASSESSED BY THE COMMISSION SHALL BE EQUAL TO THE GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION.
- (4) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, FOR FISCAL YEAR 1993 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE TOTAL USER FEES ASSESSED BY THE COMMISSION SHALL BE EQUAL TO 4 TIMES THE NET STATE CONTRIBUTION.
- (3) (5) The Commission shall pay all funds collected from user fees and application fees into the General Fund of the State.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
