(House Bill 351)

AN ACT concerning

Dentists - Continuing Education

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of Dental Examiners to adopt regulations to establish establishing continuing education requirements as a condition for the renewal of a general license to practice general dentistry; requiring persons holding a general license to practice dentistry to submit satisfactory verification of compliance with certain continuing education requirements when renewing their general for licensed dentists; requiring licensed dentists to submit satisfactory evidence of compliance with certain continuing education requirements when renewing their license to practice dentistry; specifying that the Board may not require compliance with certain regulations prior to a certain date; authorizing the Board to accept completion of certain courses as counting towards satisfaction of certain requirements; and generally relating to the renewal of a license to practice general dentistry until after a certain date; authorizing the Board to credit towards satisfaction of certain continuing education requirements certain courses completed within a certain time period; and generally relating to continuing education requirements for dentists.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

- (a) In addition to the powers set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board may:
 - (1) Adopt regulations governing:
 - (i) The administration of general anesthesia by a licensed dentist;
 - (ii) The administration of parenteral sedation by a licensed dentist;
