SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act shall be construed retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect all full time personnel of the Prince George's County Parks and Recreation Department beginning on the date of their employment as full time personnel prospectively.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 369

(House Bill 373)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission - Prince George's

County - Private Rights-of-Way

MC/PG 15-91

FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of Prince George's County to establish standards to determine if a private right of way or easement provides certain adequate access; authorizing the governing body of Prince George's County to adopt administrative procedures for the approval of a private right of way or easement that fulfills certain standards; and generally relating to the approval of private rights of way in Prince George's County that provide adequate access to building lots:

FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing bodies of Prince George's County and Montgomery County to adopt certain standards to assure that a private right-of-way or easement provides adequate access to certain building lots; authorizing the governing bodies to delegate to the respective executive branches or planning boards certain authority to approve a private right-of-way or easement that complies with certain standards; and generally relating to approval of certain private rights-of-way that provide access to building lots in Prince George's and Montgomery Counties.
