Consume Alcoholic Beverages Permit; creating a Special No Sale Bring and Consume Alcoholic Beverages Permit for issuance in Baltimore County; providing for the issuance and scope of the permit and time and days for consumption under the permit; establishing permit classes; prohibiting the issuance of the permit for use on certain licensed premises; providing that the permit is not a license for certain activities; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to adopt certain regulations regarding the permit; providing certain operation restrictions; providing a penalty for certain violators; and generally relating to a Special No Sale Bring and Consume Alcoholic Beverages Permit prohibiting, in Baltimore County, the bringing and consumption or transfer of alcoholic beverages on the premises of certain places of public entertainment; providing for certain penalties for the operator of the premises; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages and certain places of public entertainment in Baltimore County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

230.

- (A) IN-BALTIMORE COUNTY, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE, A PERSON SHALL OBTAIN A SPECIAL NO-SALE BRING AND CONSUME ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PERMIT BEFORE OPERATING A BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT THAT:
 - (1) IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC; AND
- (2) ALLOWS PATRONS TO BRING AND CONSUME ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON THE ESTABLISHMENT'S PREMISES.
- (B) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL NO SALE BRING AND CONSUME ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PERMIT IN BALTIMORE COUNTY FOR USE ON THE PREMISES OF A BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT THAT IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.
