Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Program Evaluation Act, this title and all rules and regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [1992] 2002.

CHAPTER 376

(House Bill 461)

AN ACT concerning

Calvert County Jail Loan of 1988

FOR the purpose of amending Chapter 345 of the Acts of 1988, the Calvert County Jail Loan of 1988, to alter the purpose of the loan to include the construction and equipping of the expansion, enlargement, and addition to the Calvert County Jail.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Chapter 345 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1988 Section 1

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 345 of the Acts of 1988

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Calvert County Jail Loan of 1988 in the total principal amount of \$200,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8–117; through 8–124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on
