

(1) IMPROVEMENTS THAT ARE MADE TO REAL PROPERTY WITHIN AN ESTABLISHED ZONE OF DEWATERING INFLUENCE FOLLOWING A FINAL DECISION BY THE DEPARTMENT TO ISSUE A SURFACE MINING PERMIT; OR

(2) IMPROVEMENTS THAT ARE MADE TO REAL PROPERTY FOLLOWING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A ZONE OF DEWATERING INFLUENCE AS A CONDITION OF AN EXISTING SURFACE MINE PERMIT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 380

(House Bill 536)

AN ACT concerning

World War II Memorial

FOR the purpose of establishing a World War II Memorial Commission; directing the Commission to develop recommendations for the creation of a memorial to honor those citizens of Maryland who served in action in the armed forces of the United States during that conflict; providing for the appointment of members; construing this Act to require certain support to be provided within certain existing resources by certain staff; and generally relating to the World War II Memorial Commission.

Preamble

WHEREAS, Many citizens of Maryland served in the armed forces of the United States during World War II; and

WHEREAS, The creation of a memorial to recognize the valor of those persons will ensure that their dedication, valor, and sacrifice will be remembered and honored; and

WHEREAS, The people of Maryland want the brave deeds of those men and women to be recognized; and

WHEREAS, The people of Maryland wish to honor specially those men and women who gave so much to their country and to this State during World War II; and

WHEREAS, The people of Maryland wish to establish a lasting tribute to those whose courage should now be remembered; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (a) There is a World War II Memorial Commission.
